1200 - 1400	<b>Homegrown Parkes &amp; Lunch</b> Parkes is a lively town celebrated for its community spirit, vibrant arts scene and progressive outlook. All these elements come together at Homegrown Parkes, a popular community market day that attracts thousands of visitors. Come along to enjoy fresh, locally and regionally grown produce, unique homewares, and creative artworks. Be dazzled by talented local performers, or have fun participating in one of the engaging workshops. 1400 - 1600	<b>Tour 1: Lake Endeavour</b> Lake Endeavour, the largest water storage dam in Parkes, is a tranquil site that captivates visitors with its natural beauty. Nestled at the foot of the Bumberry Hills, this destination is perfect for family outings, birdwatching, and bushwalking. In 2024, Parkes Shire Council launched an exciting initiative to elevate the visitor experience, establishing the first freshwater recreational area in Parkes Shire. Now, guests can stroll along a scenic 90-metre boardwalk, bask on the sandy beach, dive into refreshing swims, or paddle away in kayaks or dragon boats. <i>Tour includes approx. one hour of travel time. Amenities are available at Lake Endeavour.</i>	Departing from and returning to Cooke Park (bus stops are located directly opposite the intersection of Welcome and Cecile Streets)
	<b>Tour 2: Parkes Wetlands and Splash Park</b> Parkes Shire Council is embarking on an exciting project transforming the town's decommissioned wastewater treatment ponds into a vibrant, biodiverse wetland, also creating a much-needed 'blue' recreational space for the community to enjoy. This tour will allow participants to walk around the wetlands, learn about the design and construction process, and hear about the next stages of planned works. Participants will then be shuttled to Galing Gandhay, Parkes' brand-new splash park. This innovative play space was designed to mimic the topography and hydrology of the area surrounding Parkes, inspired by the rivers, dams, weirs and bores. Interpretive signage tells the story of water and explains the physics and engineering involved in natural and engineered water flow. <i>Amenities are available at the Splash Park. There are no amenities at the Parkes Wetlands.</i>	
	<b>Tour 3: The Dish (Murriyang - CSIRO's Parkes Radio Telescope)</b> The CSIRO Parkes Radio Telescope, star of the movie 'The Dish' (2000) is one of Australia's most prominent landmarks. The Visitor Discovery Centre takes you on a journey exploring the highlights of the telescope's rich history. Starting as an idea in the 1950s, see how Murriyang has matured into a world-leading research facility. Includes 30-minute 3D Theatre experience. <i>Tour includes approx. 45 minutes of travel time. Amenities are available at the Parkes Observatory.</i>
