ENVIROMENTORS®

The EnviroMentors® program is the state's longest running and furthest reaching mobile sustainability incursion program.

Backed by a professionally qualified team with experience in sustainability, environmental science and teaching, we are passionate to create a less littered, more sustainable NSW. We visit one school per day, delivering four or five interactive workshops to one class at a time to students from Kindergarten to Year 6, designed to cater for each age group. We reach up to 150 or more students per day. The workshops are designed to engage students by using interactive games, local knowledge and easy steps that students can undertake at school, share with their families and create community change.

MODULES WE TEACH

The EnviroMentors® offer a series of different workshops that cover a range of current environmental issues. All modules are designed to engage students through movement and fun activities.

Workshops are designed to encourage students to become environmental stewards in their schools and households, spreading the message to the wider community. The pace of the workshops is mixed by incorporating games, kinaesthetic learning and props to keep children engrossed and actively learning.

WASTE AUDIT PROGRAM

As well as our long-standing primary incursion education, we are excited to offer our newly designed waste audit program specifically designed for school environments, including primary, high, pre-school and OOSH centres.

By seeing the waste produced by the school first-hand through a waste audit, the children and teachers will get an understanding of exactly what is being thrown in the bins which will inform the types of bins needed and lead to classroom discussions and action plans.

RECYCLING

Through interactive games and tangible resources, students find out what and how new items are made from recycled materials. With a focus on local services, recycling to reduce waste going to landfill and saving natural resources is emphasised.

COMPOSTING

Students explore composting as an environmentally sound alternative to reduce organic waste sent to landfill. Maintaining compost and the ecosystems found within are explored through games. Schools have the option of setting up their own compost bins through this module.

IN THE BIN

Students get creative through drama while gaining knowledge of local waste issues. They learn the appropriate bin to place waste items in and consequences of incorrect bin use. The disposal of tricky waste items such as e-waste and bulky items is also explored.

WORM FARMING

Worm farming is a simple, effective way to recycle food scraps. Students enjoy discovering how a real worm farm looks and works while learning how to care for their own. Schools have the option of setting up their own worm farm through this module.

LUNCHES UNWRAPPED

The module is designed for schools wanting to reduce littering and excess packaging in school lunchboxes.

Students are introduced to the idea of a waste-free lunch and explore the benefits for both the environment and their health.



SCHOOLYARD HARVEST

The module makes the connection between growing and caring for a garden and the food we eat.

Students are guided through the steps involved in creating their own vegetable garden at school or at home. They may also learn of the benefits of keeping chickens for fresh eggs.

SUSTAINABILITY

The concept of sustainability is broken down into an easily digestible format for students. Natural resources are explored through games and students collaborate to identify actions they can take in their daily lives at home and school to consume less and conserve resources for future generations.



KEEPING WATERWAYS CLEAN

Students role-play the harmful activities carried out by characters in a catchment story. After observing the effects these actions can have on water quality and biodiversity, students brainstorm environmentally friendly practices to protect our fragile waterways. Our 3D interactive models are a fascinating component of this module.

SAVING WATER

Through puzzles and interactive demonstrations, students examine the water cycle, just how much potable water we have on earth and how we need to share this limited supply of water. Ideas to save water at home and school are played in drama activities.

LITTER

Students have the chance to learn interactively as they act out and brainstorm environmental and social impacts of littering. This inspires students from an early age to protect our environment by correctly disposing of rubbish. A litter audit can also be conducted around the school.



PROGRAM SUCCESSES/ NUMBERS

This engaging and successful program reaches approximately 36,000 students each year and visits more than 250 schools over 32 local government areas.

All participating teachers are given the opportunity to provide feedback regarding the EnviroMentors program®. This feedback provides qualitative and quantitative data for Keep Australia Beautiful NSW, ensuring continuous improvement and a program that is relevant to its clientele.
