	The Scone & Upper Hunter Historical Society History Museum was established by the Society in 1966 in the Old Scone Lock Up. The focus of the Museum is on the history of British settlement which began in the Scone area in 1825. The collection and exhibits take you back to yesteryear, with many household artifacts and agricultural tools and machinery on display.
